Dear parents / carers of the Class of 2026,

Arrangements for Examination Results

Congratulations to all Year 11 students on completing their examinations! They have reached a significant milestone in their young lives having conducted themselves brilliantly throughout the process. Thank you to students for making this year's Prom a wonderful night to remember for teachers as well as students. They looked absolutely amazing and made their teachers incredibly proud, even on the dancefloor.

We look forward to welcoming Year 11s back to school on Thursday 20th August 2026 to collect their examination results, which will be available for students to collect from 9.00am – 11.00am.

Please park in our main car park. Students will enter school through the entrance near the main girls' toilets/the Hall. We ask that you wait for your children to exit school via reception, and only come into school if you need to then accompany your child in seeking support.

We hope that this day will be a cause for great celebration for you and your child. To support students who have not achieved the results needed to enrol on to their desired college courses, Senior Leaders, our Careers Advisor and representatives from Bury College and Holy Cross College will be on hand to support. For students who have queries about post-results services (e.g. access to scripts, clerical checks or reviews of marking), Heads of Department and our Examinations Officer (Mr. Johnston) will be available to advise.

Should a student be unable to collect their results in person, they have three alternatives.

- They may nominate a representative to collect their results on their behalf. The permission slip below must be completed by the student and returned via email to exams@stgabrielshigh.stoccat.org.uk by Wednesday 19th August 2026. The nominated representative must also bring photographic ID with them on Results Day. Results will not be shared with anyone other than the student to whom they belong without both documents.
- If a student is unable to arrange for a nominated representative to collect their results, please leave a stamped addressed envelope with the Examinations Officer so the results can be posted home. Please leave this with school's reception on Friday 17th July 2026.
- Alternatively, the student can request that their results are emailed to them. This can only be to the students' personal email accounts, not their St Gabriel's account as this may be closed at that point. Students should request this service by emailing exams@stgabrielshigh.stoccat.org.uk from their personal account. Results will be emailed out after 9am on results day.

Please note we cannot share GCSE results over the phone.

The documents shared on 20th August are not your child's official GCSE certificates. We will invite students back for their Celebration Evening to collect these in the Autumn term of the new academic year; the date is to be confirmed and will be shared with you in due course, but is likely to be in late November. Students must collect their GCSE certificates and keep these safe, as they will be required to show their original

certificates at future interviews for education and employment opportunities. They will be charged by the examination boards if they lose their certificates and require replacements.

We wish you and your children a restful and restorative summer holiday after this very demanding time, and look forward to celebrating with you in August.
